This notice is to inform you of important upcoming changes in the GM Retirement Savings Plan (RSP), effective after 4 p.m. Eastern time on June 17, 2019.

The following investment funds in the RSP will be replaced with a lower cost alternative:

- The State Street Target Retirement Funds will change from State Street Target Retirement Non-Lending Series Fund Class P to State Street Target Retirement Securities Lending Series Fund Class IV.
- The State Street International Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class GM-M will change to State Street World Developed ex US Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class II.
- The State Street Emerging Markets Index Non-Lending Series Fund Class GM-M
 will change to State Street Emerging Markets Index Securities Lending Series Fund
 Class II.
- The Neuberger Berman Sustainable Equity Trust will be removed and be replaced with the Vanguard FTSE Social Index Fund.

There will also be a share class change in the following investment options:

- State Street S&P 500[®] Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class GM-M will change to State Street S&P 500[®] Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class
- State Street Russell Small/Mid Cap[®] Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class GM-M will change to State Street Russell Small/Mid Cap[®] Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class II.

In addition to the changes mentioned above, effective June 17, 2019, the State Street REIT Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class GM-M will be renamed the State Street REIT Index Securities Lending Series Fund Class II.
